INITIAL CALL

On 11/17/10 at 1758 hrs., officers were sent to the residence of 2311 S. 84 St. #2, on report of the grandson getting into a physical altercation with his grandmother.

STATEMENT OF VICTIM

Upon arrival to the residence, officers made contact with the caller/victim, Janice A. Grosskreutz, F/W, 05/16/51, who appeared to be very shaken up and emotionally distraught. Janice stated her 17 year old grandson, Gaige P. Grosskreutz, M/W, 11/04/93, who is no longer on scene, got into an argument with her. Janice stated during the argument Gaige swung a lamp into the living room wall, damaging the lamp as well as the living room wall, and then struck her across the face with an open hand, causing her pain. Janice stated her grandson has been living with her for over a year. Gaige was kicked out of his mother's house, due to his behavior and inability to get along with his mother.

Janice stated the argument between her grandson and her started after she got home from work. Janice stated Gaige was upset with her because she did not answer her cell phone when he was trying to call her after he got out of school. Gaige was caught with his cell phone in school, so it was taken away from him, therefore, Gaige trying to call Janice after he got out of school in order for her to meet up with him at school after, so he could get his phone back. Janice stated she was taken back by how Gaige spoke to her on her voicemail and was upset that he demanded her to come to his school after work, so she refused to go to school.

Janice stated when she got home, Gaige was upset and was yelling at her about not answering her cell phone and not going to school, so he could get his phone back. Janice stated the arguing subsided for a while between the two of them as she was trying to talk to him about a meeting that was at school tonight about financial aid.

Janice stated after she spoke to Gaige's mother about the meeting and his financial aid for college, Gaige was upset with her about getting involved in his life and not minding her own business. Janice stated Gaige then again continued to get upset and started arguing with her. Janice stated Gaige started throwing things around the house and was getting more and more out of control.

Janice stated she left the house, to get away from the argument and Gaige. Janice stated while she left the house she started thinking about how she should not have to leave her own house, so she returned. Janice stated she returned back home and

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tried talking to Gaige about his behavior.

Janice stated when she returned home and confronted Gaige, he lashed out at her and got into her face. Janice stated she told Gaige to get out of her house due to his behavior, but he refused to do so. Janice stated Gaige was up in her face, challenging her to kick him out of the house, and was being constantly disrespectful. Janice stated in order to get Gaige out of her face, she slapped him across his face. Janice stated Gaige's behavior was making her fearful for her safety, so she reacted and slapped Gaige to get him out of her face.

Janice stated Gaige then grabbed a lamp off of the end table in the living room and swung it at the living room wall, damaging both the lamp and the wall. Janice stated she continued to tell Gaige to leave the residence, at which time he refused to do so, and got back up into Janice's face. Janice stated as their argument continued, Gaige slapped her across the right side of her face with an open hand, which caused her pain.

Janice stated she immediately went into the kitchen and called the police regarding Gaige's behavior. Janice stated when she was on the phone, Gaige must of snuck out of the house.

DAMAGE/INJURY

The living room wall had a large whole in it- \$150
Living room lamp was damaged- \$30
A fan in the back bedroom- \$20

LACK OF CONSENT

At no time did Janice give her grandson, Gaige, permission to damaged her property or to slap her across the face, causing her pain.

Officer Wroblewski took photographs of the damage to the residence and Janice's injuries to her face. See Officer Wroblewski supplemental report for details.

72 HOUR NO CONTACT PROVISION

On 11/17/10 at 1827 hrs, I read and explained the 72 Hour-No Contact Provision to Janice. Janice stated she understood the form and signed it.

ARREST OF OFFENDER

Shortly after officers left the residence, our dispatch center received a phone call from Janice, advising that her grandson, Gaige, was outside the residence knocking on the back door. Officer Porter and Officer Ketterhagen responded to

the residence and placed Gaige into custody. I responded to the residence and took custody of Gaige and then transported him to the police station for processing.

BOOKING

Gaige was booked, fingerprinted, and photographed for Disorderly Conduct-DV and Criminal Damage- DV.

STATEMENT OF DEFENDANT

Gaige was placed into interview room#A of the booking area and was read his Miranda Rights using the West Allis Police Department Directive. Gaige stated she understood his rights and was willing to provide a voluntary statement without an attorney present. The interview was recorded with recorder #P9 and was stored on memory card #P9-1. The interview started at 1923 hrs and ended at 1928 hrs. The following is a paraphrased statement of Gaige's:

Gaige admitted to getting into an argument with his grandmother and admitted to damaging the lamp and the drywall in the living room. Gaige stated after his grandmother slapped him he didn't know what to do, so he slapped her back.

CASE DISPOSTION

Gaige was arrested for criminal damage-DV and disorderly conduct-DV. Gaige was able to post bail and was ordered down to court on 11/19/10 at 0830 for the DA charging conference.

D.A. CHARGING CONFERENCE

11-19-10 Cpl. Buerger reports: ADA Claire Trimarco reviewed the **D.V.-D.C.** and **D.V.-CDTP** charges against **Gaige P. Grosskreutz**, who was present with his Grandma (**Victim - Janice Grosskreutz**). ADA Trimarco first spoke to Janice, who requested a "State" charge not be issued. She advised that she felt she was somewhat to blame by hitting Gaige first. She stated their whole family has anger control issues, and she would like Gaige to go to some sort of family counseling with her.

Janice stated that she really didn't want to throw Gaige into the legal system at this point for this offense, and wanted to give him a chance to get on the right path. She advised they should both go to counseling to get help. ADA Trimarco decided she was not going to issue a "State" charge, [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] She then took Janice to the D.V. Advocates room to get some information on counseling for them.

ADA Trimarco then spoke to Gaige, who appeared embarrassed and remorseful for what he did. Gaige admitted he was wrong for yelling at his Grandma and hitting her.

After ADA Trimarco was finished speaking with Gaige, I gave him a bail return slip for the money his mom posted on her card. I informed Grandma that if she wanted to sign the "Waiver", she would have to go to the West Allis Police Department. Gaige was sent on his way.

ADA Trimarco marked this file as **"No Process"**, and turned the file over to Jasmine in the D.V. Unit.

NARRATIVE

On Monday, 05/28/12, at 11:30AM, I was dispatched to 13270 W. Van Norman Ave., for a report of a burglary.

Michael THOMPSON reported that someone entered his residence sometime between Sunday, 05/27/12, at 10:30PM, and today at 1:15AM, and stole three gaming systems. The suspect(s) also damaged three interior lights.

Michael's daughter, [REDACTED], informed me that she had a party last night at the residence. Several of her friends arrived during the day and they were all hanging out. [REDACTED] stated that her grandma was there for awhile but left about 5:00PM. At approximately 6:00PM, three males that [REDACTED] only knew by first name arrived. She advised their names were Gaige, Cody, and [REDACTED]. A fourth male, that she only knew as "Europa" arrived at about 7:00PM. During the party [REDACTED] stated that Cody was causing some problems by being loud and was intimidating her.

I later was able to identify the names of the four subjects as Gaige GROSSKEUTZ, Cody FOLEY, [REDACTED] and Ihor "Europa" SAHAN.

[REDACTED] stated that she had everyone leave at approximately 10:00PM, because she was going to someone else's house. She left at 10:30PM.

Michael informed me that he and the rest of the family were at a campground so the house was unoccupied. Michael called [REDACTED] stating that they were returning home because of the weather and would be home at about 1:00AM.

[REDACTED] arrived back home at 1:15AM. She noticed the service light on by the garage man door, located on the east side of the house. She went to check on the door and found it was unlocked. Upon entering the garage, she observed a shoe rack, located by the access door to the residence, was knocked to the ground.

[REDACTED] thought that maybe someone had knocked it down by accident or it fell on it's own. Michael and the rest of the family arrived home a few minutes later.

Later in the morning it was discovered that several gaming systems were missing. Michael advised that a Nintendo Wii, and a Playstation 2 and 3 were taken. Seven Playstation 3 games and a Playstation 2 game were also taken. The suspect(s) also broke three lights in the basement.

[REDACTED] stated that she believes FOLEY and SAHAN may have returned and stole the items. She stated that FOLEY was a "jerk" most of the night. I asked [REDACTED] why they were at her house. [REDACTED] is friends with GROSSKREUTZ and the others "just kind of showed up" with him. [REDACTED] stated that they left in two cars but did not know who was in each car.

[REDACTED] was only able to provide me a phone number for GROSSKREUTZ. I called him

several times and he never answered.

I was able to obtain an address for [REDACTED] I went to his residence and no one answered the door.

Cynthia THOMPSON called me with further information. She provided me with full names for FOLEY and SAHAN, which [REDACTED] obtained from Facebook.

At 2:30PM, I spoke with [REDACTED] over the phone. He stated that yesterday afternoon he was with GROSSKREUTZ and they stopped at a gas station in West Allis. There he met up with FOLEY. [REDACTED] stated that he doesn't really know FOLEY very well, but thought he was a "cool guy" and he invited FOLEY to [REDACTED] house. [REDACTED] said he is also friend's with SAHAN. He provided SAHAN with directions to [REDACTED] house and he showed up a little later. [REDACTED] stated everyone left at about 10:00PM. [REDACTED] advised that he drove GROSSKREUTZ back to his residence. [REDACTED] then went home and went to bed.

[REDACTED] later learned from [REDACTED] about the items being stolen. [REDACTED] contacted SAHAN and learned that SAHAN dropped FOLEY off at the McDonalds located at Greenfield Ave. and 84th St. SAHAN then drove home to his residence in Cedarburg. [REDACTED] gave me SAHAN'S phone number of 262-957-6101. [REDACTED] did not have any further information on FOLEY regarding phone number or address.

SAHAN did not answer my calls.

Michael called me on 05/29/12 and provided me with a phone number for FOLEY. Michael stated that [REDACTED] obtained the number from FOLEY last night. Michael also stated that a small black aluminum baseball bat and a cup of loose change was taken from his bedroom.

NARRATIVE

On Tuesday, 05-29-12, at approximately 11:30am, I reviewed this report [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] GROSSKREUTZ had three transactions listed at Mega Media Xchange, 4820 S. 76th Street located in the city of Greenfield. Two of the transactions occurred on 05-25-12, and the third transaction occurred on 05-28-12, at 1:50pm. The transaction on 05-28-12, shows GROSSKREUTZ sold two Playstation 2 core units with one being a slim deck and the other being a regular size deck. Along with the two Playstations sold were two Playstation 2 memory cards.

On the above date at 12:00pm, I contacted Mega Media Xchange and spoke with manager Ashley KLUG. I explained the circumstances to KLUG and advised her to place all of the transactions from GROSSKREUTZ on hold. While speakin [REDACTED] h [REDACTED] approximately 11:15am. KLUG stated GROSSKREUTZ was there to sell three Nintendo 64 games titled, "Perfect Dark", "1080 Snowboarding", and "Mario Party 2". KLUG confirmed there is video surveillance in the store and she would also place the Nintendo 64 games on hold pending our investigation.

Michael advised they do not have the serial numbers for the Sony PlayStation III or the Wii System that were taken in the burglary. I inquired if they still had the original packaging or receipts from the game systems as those numbers are periodically listed in those places. Michael advised they would check.

At 11:30AM, Michael called back to advise they located the serial numbers for the Sony PlayStation III and Wii Systems. The serial number listed for the Sony PlayStation III is CG312921017 and the Wii System is KU61115621. [REDACTED]

At 3:39PM, Cynthia THOMPSON, (Hereinafter referred to as Cynthia), called and left a voicemail advising she located the serial number for the missing Sony PlayStation II from the original receipt. The serial number is PK828120447.

At 9:33AM, I went to the THOMPSON residence and met with Cynthia who provided me with the Sony PlayStation II receipt. I examined the receipt and confirmed the serial number as PK828120447.

At 10:08AM, I went to Mega Media Exchange located at 4827 S. 76th Street, Greenfield, Wisconsin, and met with manager, Ashley KLUG. KLUG turned over THOMPSON's stolen Sony PlayStation II GROSSKREUTZ had sold to Mega Media Exchange. I confirmed the serial number was a match to the THOMPSONS' original sale receipt. Mega Media Exchange requests \$25.00 in restitution from GROSSKREUTZ.

I returned to the New Berlin Police Department and the Sony PS II was photographed as evidence and inventoried as recovered.

At 12:11PM, Detective SCHULTE and I went to 2311 S. 84th Street #2, in West Allis, the address of GROSSKREUTZ. I knocked on the door, GROSSKREUTZ answered and invited us into the apartment. GROSSKREUTZ was at the apartment with his girlfriend, Kathryn WENZELL, and they were playing video games. I asked

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GROSSKREUTZ about attending the party at the THOMPSON residence. GROSSKREUTZ related the following:

On May 27, 2012, GROSSKREUTZ, [REDACTED] and Cody FOLEY went to [REDACTED] THOMPSON's residence at approximately 6:00PM in [REDACTED] vehicle. They brought along with them, two - thirty packs of Pabst Blue Ribbon Beer. Later that evening, Ihor SAHAN arrived after getting off of work. Other people at the party were [REDACTED] a male by the name of, "Jordan," and four other people GROSSKREUTZ did not know.

They stayed at the residence drinking beer and swimming until about 10:00PM. The beer was gone and [REDACTED] was going to go to another party, so she asked GROSSKREUTZ and his friends to leave. GROSSKREUTZ left with [REDACTED] and FOLEY rode with SAHAN. [REDACTED] drove GROSSKREUTZ home where he arrived between the hours of 10:30PM and 11:00PM. WENZELL came to GROSSKREUTZ's apartment at about the same time and they remained there for the rest of the evening.

On Memorial Day, (May 28, 2012,) around noon, [REDACTED] called GROSSKREUTZ and said he wanted to sell two Sony Playstation II game systems. GROSSKREUTZ went to Mega Media Exchange in Greenfield with [REDACTED] and SAHAN. [REDACTED] was not old enough to make the sale and SAHAN didn't have identification, so GROSSKREUTZ sold the two PlayStation II Systems reportedly owned by [REDACTED] After making the sale, GROSSKREUTZ gave the money to [REDACTED]

Based upon the way GROSSKREUTZ was relating the information, Detective SCHULTE and I didn't believe GROSSKREUTZ was being truthful. Detective SCHULTE requested WENZELL to speak to him in the common hallway of the apartment complex. I continued to speak with GROSSKREUTZ briefly and Detective SCHULTE returned with WENZELL. Detective SCHULTE questioned GROSSKREUTZ about his honesty. GROSSKREUTZ acknowledged FOLEY and [REDACTED] stole the Wii and PS III systems along with games from the THOMPSON residence.

Based upon GROSSKREUTZ's evasiveness, I asked if he would be willing to come to the New Berlin Police Department voluntarily for an interview. GROSSKREUTZ agreed.

GROSSKREUTZ was transported to the New Berlin Police Department at approximately 12:53PM. Once at the police department, GROSSKREUTZ was invited to a detective interview room for an interview that was digitally recorded. GROSSKREUTZ was advised he was not in custody and free to leave at anytime. GROSSKREUTZ advised he understood. GROSSKREUTZ related the following information.

GROSSKREUTZ detailed events about the party, which was similar to what he said at his apartment. He added FOLEY and [REDACTED] had issues with each other because FOLEY was being too loud. FOLEY made comments that [REDACTED] needed to,

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"..get her ass beat."

On Monday May 28, 2012, [REDACTED] called GROSSKREUTZ three times between 11:00AM and 12:00PM. GROSSKREUTZ texted her back and learned someone broke into the THOMPSON residence and, "Took a bunch of stuff." GROSSKREUTZ listed a PS III Game System, game accessories, and coins. Lights were also broken in the basement of the residence.

Later that afternoon GROSSKREUTZ and [REDACTED] went to FOLEY's residence. GROSSKREUTZ saw a new Wii System there and GROSSKREUTZ got suspicious. GROSSKREUTZ wasn't sure if the Wii System belonged to the THOMPSON family but he felt it may be related.

That day an officer from the New Berlin Police Department called [REDACTED] about the burglary at the THOMPSON residence. [REDACTED] admitted to GROSSKREUTZ he was involved in the burglary. FOLEY, [REDACTED] and GROSSKREUTZ discussed the burglary and [REDACTED] said not to worry about it because, "Who has the serial number to a PS II?" GROSSKREUTZ claimed it was at this point he learned FOLEY committed the burglary as well and the Sony PS II System GROSSKREUTZ sold was stolen.

GROSSKREUTZ tried to sell another game system at Mega Media Exchange days following, but his account had been blocked. GROSSKREUTZ thought it was blocked because of the stolen PS II sale he made for [REDACTED]

GROSSKREUTZ called [REDACTED] and they discussed the blocking of the account. [REDACTED] told GROSSKREUTZ it was because GROSSKREUTZ had been selling a high volume of gaming equipment in a short period of time.

On the evening the burglary was committed, FOLEY had talked about burglaries committed in the State of Washington where he formerly resided. FOLEY spoke about the "Rules of break-ins." He cited those rules as, don't stay too long, don't sell at places like Mega Media Exchange and pull the car in the driveway to make it look like you are moving out. After loading the car with your stolen goods you would then drive off.

I asked GROSSKREUTZ if he would be willing to make a recorded phone call to [REDACTED] regarding the burglary. GROSSKREUTZ advised he would.

GROSSKREUTZ, Detective SCHULTE and I went outside into my squad and GROSSKREUTZ was fitted with a recording device capable of recording both sides of the conversation. I recorded the precursor and GROSSKREUTZ called [REDACTED] at 2:12PM, at phone number 414-552-3457.

[REDACTED] answered and GROSSKREUTZ told him detectives came by and they knew the Sony PS II was stolen. [REDACTED] asked GROSSKREUTZ what he told the police. GROSSKREUTZ told [REDACTED] the PS II was stolen and inquired if FOLEY still had the Wii System and if, "Macho," still had the PS III System. GROSSKREUTZ added

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if "Macho" and FOLEY still possessed those systems, they should return the items. [REDACTED] and GROSSKREUTZ talked about if they were going to get charged (or referred,) with a crime. [REDACTED] asked what type of questions the police asked. GROSSKREUTZ advised, the police asked what happened that night and where all the property went. [REDACTED] then asked, "So they know you broke in?" GROSSKREUTZ became nervous and responded, "No." [REDACTED] asked, "They don't know you broke in, they just know you sold a stolen PS III, ([REDACTED] then corrected himself,) or PS II?" GROSSKREUTZ responded, "No, uuuh, I didn't." [REDACTED] responded, "What do you mean you didn't?" GROSSKREUTZ pauses a long time and the call ends.

GROSSKREUTZ advised Detective SCHULTE and I there was a bad connection because [REDACTED] is at school and the call was disconnected. Detective SCHULTE tells GROSSKREUTZ he believes GROSSKREUTZ was involved in the burglary because he could partially hear what [REDACTED] was saying.

[REDACTED] called back and asked what questions the police asked GROSSKREUTZ. GROSSKREUTZ responds, "Were you with them? Were you the one who broke in? Who was with you?" [REDACTED] asked, "So they just think you sold the stolen one? They don't think you broke in do they?" GROSSKREUTZ responds, "No." [REDACTED] responds, "Good? With that all they can get you with is" The call then ends.

GROSSKREUTZ claims the call keeps cutting out and finally acknowledged he was present when the burglary occurred. SAHAN and GROSSKREUTZ stayed in the car because GROSSKREUTZ didn't want anything to do with the burglary.

At that point, [REDACTED] calls back and GROSSKREUTZ answers the call. [REDACTED] asked why GROSSKREUTZ keeps hanging up on him. GROSSKREUTZ advised [REDACTED] he believes it is on [REDACTED] end where the connection is the problem.

[REDACTED] then gives his opinion regarding GROSSKREUTZ selling the stolen Sony PlayStation II and the police can't charge GROSSKREUTZ with burglary based upon selling it. GROSSKREUTZ tells [REDACTED] they should try to "get the stuff back." They talk about getting the stolen property back in order to barter a deal.

[REDACTED] gives advice to GROSSKREUTZ telling him not to admit anything and watch his words. They continued to talk about that and GROSSKREUTZ gets nervous on the phone and the call disconnects again.

GROSSKREUTZ and I returned to the interview room from my squad to clear up earlier discrepancies in his story. GROSSKREUTZ related the following information:

GROSSKREUTZ left the THOMPSON residence and was driven back to his apartment by [REDACTED] GROSSKREUTZ arrived home and WENZELL arrived at approximately the same time. GROSSKREUTZ stayed at the apartment with WENZELL and [REDACTED] left. A

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short time later, [REDACTED] texted GROSSKREUTZ and asked if he was interested in getting some, "bag," meaning marijuana.

[REDACTED] FOLEY and SAHAN all returned to GROSSKREUTZ's apartment and they left briefly to purchase marijuana. All four subjects were in [REDACTED] car smoking marijuana in the parking at GROSSKREUTZ's apartment. As they were smoking marijuana, the topic of discussion was about FOLEY and the burglaries he committed while living in the State of Washington. Someone in the conversation then remembered [REDACTED] wasn't home. GROSSKREUTZ said one thing lead to another and it started off as a joke like, "Ha ha, let's break into this bitch's house." However, [REDACTED] and FOLEY were serious about it and it wasn't until they were actually in front of THOMPSON's house that GROSSKREUTZ realized this was actually going to happen.

They left GROSSKREUTZ's apartment and stopped at [REDACTED] house to pickup something, possibly cigarettes. They left [REDACTED] house and went to the direction of the THOMPSON residence. Once at the THOMPSON residence, [REDACTED] parked on the street. Initially, GROSSKREUTZ said he stayed in the car the entire time with SAHAN, while [REDACTED] and FOLEY entered the residence. The point of entry to the residence was a service door through the garage. [REDACTED] and FOLEY were in the residence for approximately twenty minutes when they came back with a backpack full of items. GROSSKREUTZ couldn't recall who had the backpack because he was intoxicated but recalled [REDACTED] and FOLEY told him they got, "A couple of game systems."

I didn't believe GROSSKREUTZ was being truthful and suspected he entered the house as well. I questioned GROSSKREUTZ further about that. GROSSKREUTZ related the following:

GROSSKREUTZ, [REDACTED] and FOLEY exited the car and walked up to the service door that was entered. GROSSKREUTZ saw the door was unlocked and after seeing the unlocked door GROSSKREUTZ claimed he returned to [REDACTED] vehicle and joined SAHAN.

After about twenty minutes, [REDACTED] and FOLEY exited and returned to the vehicle. They were happy and talking about the property they had stolen. As they drove, [REDACTED] said since the police didn't come, they should return to the house. GROSSKREUTZ and SAHAN told [REDACTED] six or seven cars drove past while they were in the residence. GROSSKREUTZ and SAHAN told [REDACTED] they thought he was in the residence too long. FOLEY told [REDACTED] that's the number one rule, you don't go back. [REDACTED] was determined to go back because he wanted to get a 50" flat screen television he saw. [REDACTED] tried to get the group to go in with him because he couldn't lift a 50" television by himself. FOLEY told [REDACTED] "Enough is enough." [REDACTED] responded, "Well fuck it, I'll lift it myself."

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As they returned to the THOMPSON residence, they saw [REDACTED] on the driveway so they didn't stop and drove past. They returned to GROSSKREUTZ apartment and went their separate ways for the evening.

I still did not believe GROSSKREUTZ did not enter the THOMPSON residence. I attempted, once again to get him to tell the truth. GROSSKREUTZ related the following:

GROSSKREUTZ admitted he was the one who actually opened the service door where [REDACTED] and FOLEY entered. GROSSKREUTZ took one step into the garage and claimed he backed out at that point. GROSSKREUTZ immediately recanted and said he didn't go in but acknowledged he opened the door and permitted [REDACTED] and FOLEY to enter behind him. As [REDACTED] entered he told GROSSKREUTZ, "Fuck you then pussy, we are keeping all the shit."

GROSSKREUTZ didn't know who broke the lights or took the coins. GROSSKREUTZ claimed he also didn't know the Sony PS II he sold to Mega Media Exchange belonged to the THOMPSON family. GROSSKREUTZ said [REDACTED] or FOLEY sold the stolen Sony PlayStation III to a neighbor of FOLEY. That neighbor was described as a Puerto Rican male called, "Macho." The Sony PlayStation III, accessories and games, were sold for \$100.

I concluded my interview with GROSSKREUTZ at that time. I arranged for GROSSKREUTZ to come back to the New Berlin Police Department on June 4, 2012 for booking procedures. GROSSKREUTZ agreed to return.

I listened to the recorded phone call after GROSSKREUTZ left the department. I believe GROSSKREUTZ was intentionally hanging up on [REDACTED] because the conversation was implicating GROSSKREUTZ's involvement in the burglary.

On June 4, 2012 at approximately 10:05AM, GROSSKREUTZ came in for booking procedures. GROSSKREUTZ was very quiet and hardly said anything when spoken to. I asked GROSSKREUTZ a few questions and he sat mute. I asked if he was refusing to answer me and he nodded his head to affirm that.

GROSSKREUTZ was fingerprinted and photographed at 10:20AM, and was subsequently released to the lobby.

On June 4, 2012, at approximately 8:45AM, I called FOLEY and was advised by an automated message the phone account did not have voicemail set up at this time.

At 8:47AM, I called SAHAN and was not able to leave a message as well.

On June 5, 2012, at 9:05AM, I contacted Delmar [REDACTED] (Hereinafter referred to as Delmar), father of [REDACTED] [REDACTED] regarding this investigation. Delmar was

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advised I would like to speak to his son about the burglary. I told Delmar I was 100% certain of [REDACTED] involvement regarding this burglary. Delmar said he would call [REDACTED] and would bring him in for an interview later that day. [REDACTED] never arrived for an interview nor did I receive any phone calls from Delmar.

At 9:22AM, I contacted SAHAN and arranged for an interview on June 6, 2012 at approximately 7:00AM.

At 10:10AM, I called FOLEY and received the automated message once again.

At 10:15AM, FOLEY returned my call. FOLEY was very agitated because he was being accused of burglary. FOLEY said, "Gaige (GROSSKREUTZ) said you would try to get me to say something." FOLEY advised he will come in for an interview when he is off of work, but wasn't sure when that would be.

On June 6, 2012, at 7:10AM, I interviewed SAHAN regarding his involvement in the burglary. SAHAN was invited to the detective bureau interview room where he was advised he was not under arrest and free to leave at any time. SAHAN stated he understood.

I cautioned SAHAN to make certain he is truthful so he doesn't make his situation worse. SAHAN stated he understood and related the following information:

On May 27, 2012, SAHAN got off of work from the Grand Exchange at Grand Avenue Mall, at approximately 5:00PM. SAHAN described the Grand Exchange as a pawn shop for electronics. He went home and changed, and got directions to the THOMPSON residence where he met his friends [REDACTED] GROSSKREUTZ and FOLEY.

When SAHAN arrived at the THOMPSON residence, he went swimming and was drinking beer with his associates. At 9:45PM, SAHAN and his friends left. SAHAN drove FOLEY to the McDonalds Restaurant located at South 84th Street on Greenfield Avenue in the City of West Allis. SAHAN left FOLEY there and returned home to Saint Francis.

I confronted SAHAN about his truthfulness with the facts regarding this case. SAHAN maintained that GROSSKREUTZ, [REDACTED] FOLEY and himself did not return to the THOMPSON residence. SAHAN admitted he was with [REDACTED] and GROSSKREUTZ at Mega Media Exchange and GROSSKREUTZ sold the stolen Sony PlayStation II.

I asked SAHAN if he wished to make a written statement and he did not. SAHAN was escorted to the police department lobby where he walked into the public area.

Based upon SAHAN's attempts to conceal the truth about returning to the THOMPSON residence, coupled with, going to Mega Media Exchange with

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GROSSKREUTZ and [REDACTED] where THOMPSON's PlayStation II was sold, it was my belief SAHAN served in the capacity of surveillance while the burglary was committed. SAHAN had several opportunities to exclude himself from returning to the THOMPSON residence, when the point of returning was to commit the burglary. SAHAN left his vehicle at GROSSKREUTZ's apartment and went as a passenger in [REDACTED] vehicle after the group decided to return to commit the burglary.

While en route to the burglary, [REDACTED] stopped at his residence giving SAHAN another opportunity to exclude himself. SAHAN stayed with the group the entire time and remained in the vehicle while the burglary was committed according to GROSSKREUTZ. SAHAN refused to be truthful even when given details about the case which shows an attempt to conceal the truth adding his involvement in the burglary and my belief that he served as a look out. SAHAN also went to Mega Media Exchange with GROSSKREUTZ and [REDACTED] when THOMPSON's Play Station II was sold.

Once in the public area of the police department lobby, I stopped SAHAN and advised him he was under arrest for burglary. SAHAN was handcuffed according to department policy at approximately 7:29AM and was escorted back to the interview room.

Once in the interview room, SAHAN was searched and everything was removed from his pockets. I did not locate anything illegal on his person. I removed the handcuffs and SAHAN was seated in the interview room.

I read to SAHAN, his Constitutional Rights, off of a State of Wisconsin, Department of Justice card. SAHAN understood his rights and chose not to make a statement. SAHAN was escorted to the booking room where he was fingerprinted and photographed. After booking procedures were complete, SAHAN was released to the lobby.

On June 11, 2012, at 10:52AM, I called Delmar in order to schedule an interview with his son, [REDACTED] I received his voicemail and left a message.

At 10:54AM, I called FOLEY, receiving an automated message advising the voicemail had not been set up, so I could not leave a message.

At 2:06PM, FOLEY returned my call and related the following:

FOLEY is still trying to get a day off of work to come in for an interview. He will contact me when he knows he is off. He asked if I would be willing to conduct the interview at the West Allis Police Department because it would be easier for him to get there. I told FOLEY I would be willing to pick him up and drive him if a ride was the issue. FOLEY questioned my truthfulness by saying, "You say that now on the phone."

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FOLEY inquired about what he had supposedly done in the State of Washington, because he is a mover and he would have a lot of burglaries on his record if that was his thing. I told him the information was relayed to me by someone and that was how I learned of it. (SAHAN had obviously spoken to FOLEY and related that information.) FOLEY became upset because he didn't do anything and if people were talking about him he would come in and tell me the entire truth, like an, "open book and not half the truth those guys are saying." He voiced displeasure about GROSSKREUTZ because, he thought GROSSKREUTZ must have provided the police with information.

FOLEY advised he would stay in contact with me in order to schedule an interview soon.

On June 29, 2012 at approximately 7:46AM, [REDACTED] called to inquire if he would be able to come in for an interview later that day. [REDACTED] mentioned he wasn't feeling well, but wanted to, "get it (the interview) over with."

I told [REDACTED] he should come in a different day if he was ill. [REDACTED] insisted upon coming in that day, without his father. [REDACTED] did not want his father with him because [REDACTED] "Didn't want him around."

I spoke to Delmar and he advised [REDACTED] wanted to come in by himself and gave me permission to speak with his son. [REDACTED] was scheduled to come to the New Berlin Police Department at approximately 10:00AM.

At 9:26AM, [REDACTED] called and asked if he could come in later than the scheduled time. I advised that would be fine.

At 10:27AM, I was notified by New Berlin Police Department Records Technician, Merry RYMER, [REDACTED] had arrived for his interview. RYMER advised [REDACTED] was acting odd and sweating profusely as he spoke to her at the front window. It should be noted, temperatures were high that day, but the condition of [REDACTED] was not common with others who came into the lobby that day.

At 10:32AM, [REDACTED] was invited to a detective bureau interview room. [REDACTED] was advised he was not in custody and was free to leave at any time. [REDACTED] advised he understood and related the following:

[REDACTED] denied any involvement in the burglary. He acknowledged going to the THOMPSON residence, "getting drunk and having a fun time." When the party concluded, [REDACTED] drove GROSSKREUTZ home and then went home himself. [REDACTED] admitted he should not have been driving because he was, "Drunk as hell."

I played the portion of the recorded phone conversation between [REDACTED] and GROSSKREUTZ as they discussed details regarding the burglary. As the recording played, [REDACTED] became noticeably nervous. [REDACTED] continued to deny his involvement and told me he was aware of the recorded conversation. [REDACTED]

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advised he spoke to different attorneys and did research on his own regarding the recorded phone call. [REDACTED] thought the conversation could not be used against him if he was not aware he was being recorded. [REDACTED] was advised the recording was obtained legally.

[REDACTED] admitted driving GROSSKREUTZ and SAHAN to Mega Media Exchange in order to sell the two Sony PlayStation 2 units the day after the burglary. I told [REDACTED] he received money from the sale, (as reported by GROSSKREUTZ). [REDACTED] did not deny receiving payment.

[REDACTED] inquired several times what would happen to him if he told the truth. [REDACTED] asked me, "Hypothetically speaking, what would happen if I were to give the truth?" At that point [REDACTED] became nervous and stood up in the interview room. [REDACTED] was immediately directed to sit back down and responded by saying, "I'm sticking to my story....sticking to my story, one hundred percent."

I asked [REDACTED] to explain how GROSSKREUTZ came into contact with the stolen PlayStation II from the THOMPSON residence after being there the previous day. [REDACTED] responded by saying, "That was not in my trunk, (pause) not in my car." [REDACTED] added GROSSKREUTZ was the one who possessed the two game units that were sold at Mega Media Exchange.

At this time my interview with [REDACTED] was complete and I asked if [REDACTED] would be willing to go through booking procedures. [REDACTED] agreed.

While waiting for another detective, I advised [REDACTED] his driving status was suspended through the State of Wisconsin. [REDACTED] admitted driving to the police department and requested that I allow him to drive his vehicle home. I advised [REDACTED] other arrangements would need to be made as driving from the Police Department was not option.

During my contact with [REDACTED] I noticed his speech was slurred, and the longer I spoke to him, the slurring intensified. While walking down the hallway to the booking room, I noticed [REDACTED] staggering as if he was impaired. I didn't notice the odor of intoxicants coming from [REDACTED] so I felt the impairment may be drug related.

[REDACTED] denied taking any drugs. I requested [REDACTED] to go through a sampling of Field Sobriety Tests which he was not able to complete. [REDACTED] was not able to stand on one leg for more than two seconds. [REDACTED] advised he was tired and that was his reason for not being able to perform the tests.

In the booking room, I noticed [REDACTED] pupils were dilated 4 to 5 times greater than the pupils of Detective CLEVENSTINE. I asked [REDACTED] if had taken any drugs. [REDACTED] said he has not and later admitted to taking over the counter sleeping medications. Due to the level of [REDACTED] impairment, I did not

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believe him and advised he would only be released to a parent or an adult after booking procedures.

I called Delmar and explained the situation of the impairment and that fact that [REDACTED] driver's license was suspended. Delmar agreed to come to the police department to take custody of [REDACTED]. I expressed my concern of [REDACTED] condition to Delmar and he advised he would take [REDACTED] to the doctor for examination. [REDACTED] went through booking procedures and continually denied taking anything other than sleeping pills the evening before. [REDACTED] was told he would be examined by a Drug Recognition Expert. Upon being told that, [REDACTED] became nervous. At that point, Delmar arrived in the department lobby and I went to inform him of the situation. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] was escorted to the lobby where he was turned over to Delmar. Delmar was advised [REDACTED] had taken two of his pills. Delmar was cautioned about the storage of the pills and advised he should make a better effort to secure them from [REDACTED]

On July 5, 2012 at approximately 2:44PM, I called FOLEY and advised he would need to come in by the end of next week for an interview and booking. FOLEY became angry and said he would need to schedule a time where it was convenient for him and not around my work schedule. FOLEY was told he would need to come in, otherwise he would be arrested in the near future. FOLEY hung up the phone at that point.

On July 19, 2012, at approximately 10:30AM, FOLEY returned my call and advised he would be able to come in for an interview and booking this date. FOLEY requested to be picked up due to the fact he is not able to obtain a ride. FOLEY was advised I would pick him up.

At approximately 12:31PM, Captain HINGISS and I went to 2067 S. 78th Street, in West Allis and met with FOLEY. FOLEY met us on the street and consented to a pat down for weapons prior to transport. FOLEY was invited to the department on his own accord. FOLEY was seated in the front seat of my squad during transport.

Once at the station, FOLEY was invited to an interview room, where he was advised he was not under arrest and free to leave at any time. FOLEY advised he understood. FOLEY related the following information regarding the burglary at the THOMPSON residence:

On May 27, 2012, at approximately 6:00PM to 6:30PM, [REDACTED] drove to FOLEY's residence in order to pick him up. Inside of [REDACTED] car were two - 30 packs of Pabst Blue Ribbon Beer. [REDACTED] drove to GROSSKREUTZ's and picked him up as well. [REDACTED] drove FOLEY and GROSSKREUTZ to THOMPSON's residence where they

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went swimming and consumed the beer they brought with them. Approximately 30 minutes later, SAHAN arrived.

FOLEY and his associates continued swimming and drinking. FOLEY was intoxicated when [REDACTED] produced a pipe with marijuana and passed it around allowing everyone to smoke from it. The only person who didn't smoke the marijuana, was a friend of [REDACTED] who FOLEY described as an "Asian girl."

GROSSKREUTZ and [REDACTED] went inside the residence and came back out a short time later. GROSSKREUTZ told FOLEY [REDACTED] and stole her Apple iPod [REDACTED] GROSSKREUTZ told FOLEY there was a PlayStation III game unit in the basement and asked if FOLEY wanted to take it. FOLEY advised GROSSKREUTZ he was not interested. SAHAN and [REDACTED] were in the pool during the conversation between FOLEY and GROSSKREUTZ.

FOLEY said [REDACTED] didn't like him for whatever reason. [REDACTED] was described as being rude and FOLEY did not know why she was rude to him.

At approximately 10:00PM, [REDACTED] was leaving the residence to go to another party so FOLEY and his associates left the THOMPSON residence. FOLEY was driven to his residence by SAHAN, followed by [REDACTED] and GROSSKREUTZ in [REDACTED] vehicle. While at FOLEY's residence, GROSSKREUTZ said, "Let's just get on some hot boy shit and rob her ([REDACTED] house)." FOLEY and the others all agreed that they shouldn't do that but they all got in [REDACTED] vehicle and headed towards the THOMPSON residence anyway. When FOLEY and his associates returned to the THOMPSON residence, GROSSKREUTZ exited the vehicle and rang the doorbell a few times. No one answered so GROSSKREUTZ and [REDACTED] went into the house, while FOLEY and SAHAN stayed in the car. While GROSSKREUTZ and [REDACTED] were committing the burglary, GROSSKREUTZ broke all of the lights with a baseball bat that FOLEY reported was later located by the West Allis Police Department.

GROSSKREUTZ and [REDACTED] were in the house for approximately 35 minutes and FOLEY and SAHAN saw about ten vehicles drive past while they were waiting outside in [REDACTED] vehicle. FOLEY was nervous and wanted to leave however he did not have any other means for transportation other than [REDACTED] When GROSSKREUTZ and [REDACTED] returned, FOLEY saw they had property from the house but was not able to see exactly what it was due to darkness. They all got into [REDACTED] vehicle and left the area of the residence.

While driving away, [REDACTED] wanted to return to the residence in order to take a television. [REDACTED] drove around the block and ultimately drove into a ditch and got stuck. They were able to push the vehicle out of the ditch and [REDACTED] drove back to the THOMPSON residence. While driving past the residence, they saw [REDACTED] sitting outside so they drove by.

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The following day, GROSSKREUTZ called FOLEY and asked if he was interested in buying a Wii game system. FOLEY told GROSSKREUTZ he was not interested.

I asked a follow up questions regarding the bat FOLEY said was recovered by the West Allis Police Department. FOLEY related the following:

FOLEY saw GROSSKREUTZ come out of the THOMPSON residence with a small bat in hand. GROSSKREUTZ told FOLEY he broke out all of the lights in the house to make it look like a legit robbery. Sometime after the burglary, someone saw the bat was thrown out of the window of [REDACTED] vehicle and called the West Allis Police to report it. [REDACTED] was later contacted by the police regarding the incident.

I told FOLEY I believed he had more of an active role in the burglary than he advised. FOLEY hung his head low and began to cry. FOLEY continued to deny entering the residence and then became angry. At that point, FOLEY no longer wanted to speak with me regarding the burglary.

The booking room was occupied at the time so FOLEY waited in the police department lobby until the booking room was available. When the booking room became available, FOLEY was fingerprinted and photographed. FOLEY did not wish to make a written statement and after booking procedures were complete I drove FOLEY back to his residence.

On July 23, 2012 at approximately 8:00AM, I contacted the West Allis Police Department and spoke to Detective Jon LOVAS. Detective LOVAS was able to locate a call detail report from May 28, 2012 at approximately 2:00PM, where a baseball bat was thrown from [REDACTED] vehicle. According to the comments in the report, [REDACTED] was contacted by West Allis Police Officer, James HERKOWSKI. [REDACTED] acknowledged his friend threw the bat out of the window and it was, "Stupid."

At 9:30AM, I left a message for the witness in the bat throwing incident, Carl SKROBACK to call me.

At approximately 10:00AM, I contacted Cynthia to ascertain if [REDACTED] was missing her iPod as FOLEY reported. Cynthia related the following information:

The iPod and two collector knives were noticed to be missing several days after the burglary occurred. Cynthia felt it was too late to call and report those items as missing. Cynthia was not aware of the model or serial number for the iPod. The knives were purchased from Custer Park during a family vacation. The knives were valued at approximately \$20.00. The knives were described as having a folding blade and one had a spider web handle design and the other depicted bison scene.

Cynthia was ultimately able to locate the original box from [REDACTED] iPod. Cynthia advised unit is described as a Nano, purple in color with serial number SU9460Y6721, Model A1320. The iPod was entered as stolen, (NCIC number 00222228.)

On July 26, 2012, at 11:20AM, West Allis Police Detective Jon LOVAS and I went to 2071 S. 78th Street in West Allis in order to speak to "Macho," who was identified as a Puerto Rican male.

We made contact at the door with a male subject and I asked to speak to "Macho." The male subject advised he was "Macho" and verbally identified himself as Julio CAMACHO. I asked CAMACHO about the purchase of a Sony Play Station 3 game system and CAMACHO related the following:

CAMACHO purchased the Play Station 3 game system and games from a friend [REDACTED] who he did not know. The friend was described as a taller, thin male. The complete system was sold to CAMACHO for \$150. After the sale was made, [REDACTED] came back a few days later and said he needed to buy the unit back and would pay more than \$150 CAMACHO paid. Fearing the unit was stolen, CAMACHO sold the unit back to [REDACTED]

CAMACHO knows [REDACTED] and FOLEY, but was not familiar with GROSSKREUTZ. Based upon the description of the seller, I believe GROSSKREUTZ sold the Play Station 3 system to CAMACHO.

CAMACHO and I agreed to meet on July 31, 2012, to view a photographic lineup in order to determine the seller's identity.

At 11:35AM, Detective LOVAS and I met with West Allis Police Officer James HERKOWSKI who investigated the incident where the bat was thrown from [REDACTED] vehicle. HERKOWSKI related the following information:

SKROBACK was driving in the City of Milwaukee, near the West Allis border, when he observed a bat thrown from the window of [REDACTED] vehicle. SKROBACK, who is a corrections officer for the Milwaukee County Sheriff, thought the bat may be related to a crime so he called the police and followed the [REDACTED] vehicle. [REDACTED] was ultimately stopped by HERKOWSKI and admitted his friend threw the bat out of the window because he didn't want it anymore. HERKOWSKI contacted the Milwaukee Police Department and advised about the bat. It was unknown if the bat was recovered.

He thought there was possibly, up to three occupants in the vehicle.</p> <p>On July 31, 2012, at approximately 1:57PM, Det. CLEVENSTINE and I met with CAMACHO in the parking lot of the McDonald's Restaurant, located at 8301 W. Greenfield Avenue in West Allis. The purpose of the meeting was to show CAMACHO a photographic lineup containing a picture of GROSSKREUTZ and interview CAMACHO in further detail.</p> <p>CAMACHO entered our department vehicle and sat in the front seat while Det. CLEVENSTINE sat in the right, rear passenger seat. I read to CAMACHO, the Witness Instruction for Sequential Photo Arrays. CAMACHO stated he understood the array procedure and signed the form.</p> <p>I allowed CAMACHO to view the photograph and envelope number 1. CAMACHO immediately ruled out that photograph. CAMACHO selected the photograph in envelope number 2, the photograph of GROSSKREUTZ, as the suspect. CAMACHO advised he was, "Seventy percent sure," GROSSKREUTZ was the suspect who sold the PlayStation III System to him. CAMACHO initialed the back of the photograph indicating his selection, along with the date and time.</p> <p>I subsequently interviewed CAMACHO regarding the purchase he made of the suspected stolen PlayStation III System. CAMACHO related the following:</p> <p>CAMACHO could not recall the exact date, but approximately a month or two ago, there were 7 to 8 male subjects talking between his residence and the residence to the north. CAMACHO knew a few of the subjects as they are common visitors to the neighbors' residence. (It should be noted, this is the residence where FOLEY resides.)</p> <p>The group was talking about a Sony PlayStation III System that may be for sale. [REDACTED] approached CAMACHO and asked if he wanted to purchase it. CAMACHO expressed interest and inquired how many gigabytes the unit has and what was all included with the system. GROSSKREUTZ removed the Sony PlayStation III System from a black backpack. Included were two remotes, a couple of games and the connector cords. GROSSKREUTZ also asked if CAMACHO was interested in purchasing a Wii System, which was black in color. CAMACHO already had two Wii Systems so he declined.

CAMACHO connected the Sony PlayStation III System to his television and it did not work right away. After about thirty minutes, GROSSKREUTZ and CAMACHO were able to get the PlayStation III System operating. CAMACHO paid GROSSKREUTZ either \$125.00 or \$150.00 in cash and maintained possession of the game system.

The following day, [REDACTED] called and wanted the Sony PlayStation III System back and offered to pay more than what CAMACHO paid for it. CAMACHO suspected the game system was stolen at that time and told [REDACTED] to give him back what he had paid to GROSSKREUTZ. [REDACTED] arrived a few minutes later and returned the money to CAMACHO and in turn, [REDACTED] took possession of the Sony PlayStation III System. CAMACHO later heard from a neighbor, [REDACTED] and GROSSKREUTZ were going to return the Sony PlayStation III System to the owner in order to avoid issues with the law.

I asked CAMACHO to complete a written statement. CAMACHO requested to dictate the statement and I would write it for him. CAMACHO gave his statement to me verbally and I completed the statement for him. CAMACHO signed the statement and initialed one area where an error was corrected.

NARRATIVE

INITIAL CONTACT

On 05/27/13 at 1802hrs Jarynlee J. Thurna, M/W 03/27/92, came into the station to report the top portion of his bedroom window was smashed in while he was in his room. I spoke with Thurna regarding the incident.

STATEMENT OF THURNA

Thurna explained he was at his residence, hanging out in his bedroom, with his friend, Kathryn C. Wenzel, F/W 05/05/94. While Thurna and Wenzel were hanging out together, Wenzel received multiple text messages from her former boyfriend, Gaige P. Grosskreutz, M/W 11/04/93, wanting to speak with her. Wenzel ignored several of the text messages she received from Grosskreutz, but would respond to him occasionally.

Around 0400hrs while Thurna and Wenzel were in Thurna's bedroom, they heard his bedroom window shatter. Thurna stated he looked outside and observed Grosskreutz get into his vehicle and leave the area. Thurna knew Grosskreutz and his vehicle because he met him in the past.

Wenzel was receiving text messages from Grosskreutz before and after the window was shattered, and she replied to one of his messages by saying, "Because wow on top of burglary I don't think your lawyer wants to hear about you breaking windows." Grosskreutz replied to Wenzel's text message by saying, "I'm about to come back and it's not going to be pretty so you better answer."

Thurna said his mother, Tania M. Radionov, F/W 10/11/64, was aware of the incident and wanted Thurna to take care of it. Thurna advised he wanted Grosskreutz

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arrested for the incident, and he would be willing to testify in court regarding it.

DAMAGED PROPERTY

-Top portion of a bedroom window
Estimated total to fix the window is \$100.

LACK OF CONSENT

Neither Thurna nor his mother, Radionov, gave Grosskreutz consent to smash in the top portion of his bedroom window.

CONTACT WITH GROSSKREUTZ

On 05/29/13 I contacted Grosskreutz by phone, using the number listed in our local Phoenix system. I told Grosskreutz I needed him to come to the station and speak with me regarding the incident that occurred at Thurna's residence. Grosskreutz advised he would not be able to make it today, but he could come to the station at 1700hrs tomorrow, 05/30/13, to speak with me.

After I got off the phone with Grosskreutz, I received a voicemail from his attorney requesting to speak with me regarding the incident. I called the attorney back and explained the incident to him. I told the attorney Grosskreutz could either come in and speak with me regarding the incident, or I would mail him his citation. Grosskreutz's attorney advised either he or Grosskreutz would get back to me tomorrow 05/30/13.

ARREST OF OFFENDER

On 05/30/13 around 1700hrs Grosskreutz turned himself in at the station. Grosskreutz was taken into custody and brought down to the booking room for processing.

CUSTODIAL INTERVIEW

On 05/30/13 at approx. 1728hrs, while in the booking room of the West Allis Police Department, I read Grosskreutz his Miranda Warnings off Departmental Directive 42.016. Grosskreutz agreed to speak with me regarding this incident. This interview was audio recorded on an Olympus DS-2220 Digital Voice Recorder and saved on a departmental media card (P7-2) and stored in the Technical and Forensics Bureau. Grosskreutz's statement here is paraphrased for this report.

Grosskreutz explained he and his girlfriend, Wenzel, agreed to meet up at midnight. Grosskreutz stated later in the evening, Wenzel called him saying she no

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longer wanted to meet up with him, and Grosskreutz was fine with it.

Grosskreutz said sometime late in the evening, he saw a post Wenzel put on Twitter advising she was still awake. Grosskreutz stated since Wenzel was still awake, he decided to go over to her house to see her. Grosskreutz advised he showed up at Wenzel's house, but she was not home.

Grosskreutz advised he had a feeling she was going to be at another male party's residence, Thurna, and drove over to his house to see if she was there. Grosskreutz stated he was about to knock on the back door of Thurna's residence when he heard moaning coming from Thurna's bedroom.

Grosskreutz explained he was upset and started knocking on the window to Thurna's bedroom. Grosskreutz stated he knocked three separate times, and on the third time, he broke the window, which was unintentional. Grosskreutz said due to the fact he was so angry, he decided to leave the residence to prevent further problems. Grosskreutz advised he did not leave the residence just because he broke the window.

CASE DISPOSITION

Grosskreutz was arrested for Criminal Damage to Property and processed at the station under **#2013002462**. Grosskreutz was issued a municipal citation, **M130024621**, and released. His local court date is set for 07/01/13 at 0830hrs.

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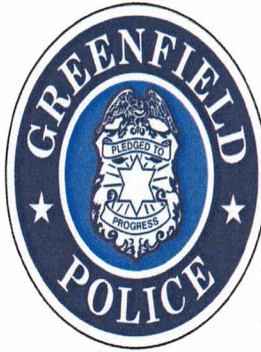

green 1999 Toyota Camry. I activated my emergency lights, initiating a traffic stop on this vehicle. The vehicle stopped in the 9800 block of West Beloit Road.

I exited my squad car and approached the driver's side window of the vehicle where I identified myself as a Greenfield Police Officer. I also informed the driver why I had stopped his vehicle. I asked the driver if there was any reason for going through the red light and he said there was no reason. I asked if he saw the traffic signal change and he said he saw the light turn to red and he was just trying to get home. I asked the driver for his driver's license, and he provided me his Wisconsin photo driver's license, identifying him as GAIGE P. GROSSKREUTZ, M/W, DOB 11/04/93. As I was speaking to GROSSKREUTZ, I could tell that his eyes were bloodshot and glassy. I also could detect an odor of intoxicants emitting from the vehicle. I asked GROSSKREUTZ where he was coming from and he told me a friend's in Waukesha. He then told me he came from a bar about an hour ago where he had a couple drinks. He also told me he had enough to be under the legal drinking limit. I asked GROSSKREUTZ for insurance and he told me he did not have any insurance on the vehicle. I had GROSSKREUTZ remain in the vehicle while I returned to my patrol car where I conducted a records check of him. On the records check it showed GROSSKREUTZ had a valid open warrant with the Racine County Sheriff's Department. I notified dispatch of this warrant and Officer Kummer was then dispatched to my location. Also on the records check I did not notice any prior Operating While Intoxicated incidents.

Upon Officer Kummer's arrival, I re-approached the driver's side door of the vehicle and had GROSSKREUTZ shut off the vehicle and step out. Dispatch also advised that the open warrant with Racine County Sheriff's Department was also confirmed. Before GROSSKREUTZ exited the vehicle, he informed me that he had a firearm on his person. He said it was also openly carried. I asked if he had a permit for this and he told me yes. Later GROSSKREUTZ told me he was currently working on getting his concealed carry permit. GROSSKREUTZ kept his hands out the windows, I opened the door, and asked him to step out. GROSSKREUTZ stepped out of the vehicle with his hands up and I then disarmed him. I took possession of a Fourth Generation Glock 19 9mm semiautomatic handgun, serial #YTB075, that was located near his right hip in a black leather holster on his belt. I then gave this firearm to Officer Kummer who then unloaded the firearm. It should be noted that there was a 9mm round in the chamber of the weapon. This firearm was then secured in the front of my patrol car.

I had GROSSKREUTZ step to the rear of his vehicle where I asked him about the firearm. He said it was open carry and that he was carrying it due to his car being broken into a lot. He did admit that he was not suppose to have it and that he did admit to drinking.

Standardized Field Sobriety Tests

The standardized field sobriety tests were conducted on the damp and level paved roadway of the 9800 block of West Beloit Road, which was free of debris. My squad headlights lit the area.

Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus Test

Before I administered the horizontal gaze nystagmus test, I asked GROSSKREUTZ if he had any recent head injuries or concussions, or if he was blind in any eyes, or if he had been to the dentist in the past 24 hours. He told me he did not. I instructed GROSSKREUTZ to stand with his feet together and his arms down at his sides. I instructed GROSSKREUTZ not to move from this position until I told him to do so. I asked GROSSKREUTZ if he understood the instructions and he told me he did. I instructed GROSSKREUTZ to follow the tip of my pen with his eyes and his eyes only, keeping his head still.

I noticed GROSSKREUTZ's pupils were of equal size and tracked together. I observed lack of smooth pursuit in both his left and right eye. I also noticed there was distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation in both his left and right eye. I also detected nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in both his left and right eye. I did detect a vertical nystagmus in both his left and right eye.

Walk and Turn Test

I had GROSSKREUTZ imagine a straight line on the pavement going towards my squad car. I had GROSSKREUTZ place his left foot on this line and told him to place his right foot in front of his left foot, touching heel to toe. I instructed GROSSKREUTZ to keep his arms down at his sides and not to move from this position until I told him to do so. I asked him if he understood the instructions and he said he understood. I explained and demonstrated the test to GROSSKREUTZ and he was not to start until I told him to do so.

I instructed GROSSKREUTZ from the starting position to take nine heel to toe steps forward on the line, turn around in the manner that I was demonstrating to him by taking a series of small steps, and to take nine more heel to toe steps back on the line. I instructed GROSSKREUTZ that while he was doing this, he was to look at his feet, count the steps out loud, keep his hands at his sides, and not to stop walking until the test was completed. As I was demonstrating this test to GROSSKREUTZ, he did not stay in the heel to toe starting position.

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GROSSKREUTZ was able to complete the first set of nine heel to toe steps. On the second set of nine heel to toe steps, on step #5 he stepped off of the line and on step #6 he missed heel to toe.

One Leg Stand Test

Once the walk and turn test was completed, I instructed GROSSKREUTZ to stand with his feet together with his arms at his sides. I told GROSSKREUTZ that when I told him to, he was to pick up either his left or his right foot and to pick that foot up approximately six inches off of the ground with his foot parallel to the ground. I instructed him to keep his hands at his sides and to count in the following manner, "one thousand one, one thousand two, one thousand three", and so on until I told him to stop. I told GROSSKREUTZ to look at his foot, keep his hands at his sides, and count out loud until I told him to stop. I asked GROSSKREUTZ if he understood the instructions and he told me he did.

GROSSKREUTZ picked up his left foot. GROSSKREUTZ was able to complete this test, but it should be noted that GROSSKREUTZ did not have his foot lifted the approximately six inches off of the ground as instructed.

Preliminary Breath Test

After the one leg stand test, I asked GROSSKREUTZ if he would like to submit to a preliminary breath test. GROSSKREUTZ agreed and he was able to provide a sufficient breath sample that resulted in a 0.16.

Based on the standardized field sobriety tests, I decided to place GROSSKREUTZ into custody. I had GROSSKREUTZ face away from me and place his hands behind his back. GROSSKREUTZ was then placed into handcuffs that were checked for proper fit and safety locked. He was searched incident to lawful arrest with negative results. GROSSKREUTZ was then placed in the rear seat of my patrol vehicle where he was seat belted in. N&S Towing was contacted by dispatch to tow the vehicle away from the scene. Before N&S Towing arrived, I searched the vehicle for any intoxicants with negative results. On the search of the vehicle, I located another full Glock pistol magazine and two boxes of 9mm pistol ammunition.

At 2:38 AM, I read GROSSKREUTZ the Informing the Accused. This form was read verbatim to him. When asked, "Will you submit to an evidentiary chemical test of your blood?" GROSSKREUTZ asked to have a section of the Informing the Accused read to him again. I read this second to him again verbatim. He then agreed to provide an evidentiary chemical test of his blood. Shortly thereafter, N&S Towing arrived on scene and removed the vehicle from the scene.

GROSSKREUTZ was transported to the Greenfield Police Department where he was placed in a holding cell. GROSSKREUTZ was searched again with negative results. He was then unhandcuffed. Necessary intake forms were completed.

From the Greenfield Police Department, GROSSKREUTZ was transported to St. Luke's Hospital where a legal blood draw was performed. Once at St. Luke's Hospital, I met with phlebotomist ANN V. WROBLEWSKI, F/W, DOB 10/31/58, who performed the blood draw. I witnessed the blood draw from GROSSKREUTZ's right arm. I provided the sealed State Laboratory of Hygiene blood kit to WROBLEWSKI and she opened it in my presence. At 4:30 AM, WROBLEWSKI performed the blood draw and sealed the two tubes of blood in the blood kit in the prescribed manner in my presence. She then turned the kit back over to me. The kit remained in my possession until I placed it into the Greenfield Police Department property room.

I placed GROSSKREUTZ back into handcuffs and transported him back to the Greenfield Police Department. Once back at the Greenfield Police Department, I completed the Alcohol/Drug Influence Report form at 5:35 AM. I read GROSSKREUTZ his pre-interrogation warning and his waiver of rights. After reading his pre-interrogation warning and waiver of rights, GROSSKREUTZ did not want to make a statement to me. At 5:38 AM, I read GROSSKREUTZ his Miranda Rights off of the Miranda Rights warning card that I was issued by the Greenfield Police Department. GROSSKREUTZ agreed to answer questions without a lawyer present. I then took his statement. GROSSKREUTZ told me he was coming from his friend's house in New Berlin, and they were just hanging out and talking. I asked if he was coming from a bar and he said he did, however, he said he did not remember the name of the bar or where it was located. I asked GROSSKREUTZ how much he had to drink and he then requested an attorney present. I then ended the interview.

GROSSKREUTZ was booked for Operating While Intoxicated, First Offense, and Operating or Posses a Firearm While Intoxicated, and also his warrant with the Racine County Sheriff's Department. GROSSKREUTZ was able to make phone calls and come up with the money for bail. A short time later, PATRICIA M. WENZEL arrived on scene at the Greenfield Police Department and paid the bail. I also completed the OAWI release form with her and she signed and initialed the form agreeing to take custody of GROSSKREUTZ.

Once bail had been posted and GROSSKREUTZ was issued his copy of the Informing the Accused, I issued him three uniform traffic citations for Violation of a Red Traffic Control Signal, Operating a Motor Vehicle Without Insurance, and OWI. Count 1: ENDANGERING SAFETY BY USE OF DANGEROUS WEAPON (UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF INTOXICANT)

The above-named defendant on or about Saturday, May 09, 2015, at 9800 block of West Beloit Road, in the City of Milwaukee, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, did go armed with a firearm while under the influence of an intoxicant, contrary to sec. 941.20(1)(b), 939.51(3)(a) Wis. Stats.

Upon conviction for this offense, a Class A Misdemeanor, the defendant may be fined not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), or imprisoned not more than nine (9) months, or both.

PROBABLE CAUSE

I am a City of Greenfield law enforcement officer and I base this complaint upon my review of official Greenfield Police Department incident reports, which are of the kind I have used in the past and found to be truthful and reliable and which I know are prepared in the ordinary and regular course of business. Said reports indicate the following:


On May 9, 2015, City of Greenfield Police Officer John Lucas was stopped facing north at W. Beloit Rd. at a red light on the westbound I-894 exit ramp and the traffic light turned green for him when he observed a green Toyota Camry traveling northeast on W. Beloit Rd. and saw the vehicle travel through a red light. The vehicle did not make an attempt to slow down or stop and would have hit the squad car had it proceeded into the intersection. A traffic stop was subsequently conducted in the 9800 block of W. Beloit Rd., (City and County of Milwaukee). The driver of the vehicle was identified as the above-named Defendant Gaige Grosskreutz.

Officer Lucas could detect an odor of intoxicants emitting from the vehicle and noticed that Grosskreutz's eyes were bloodshot and glassy. Grosskreutz said he was coming from a friend's in Waukesha and he then said he came from a bar about an hour ago where he had a couple drinks. Grosskreutz was eventually asked to exit the vehicle and before he did, he informed the officer that he had a firearm on his person and that it was openly carried. Grosskreutz said he was working on getting his CCW permit. Officer Lucas would recover a 9mm Glock 19 semi-automatic handgun that was located near Grosskreutz's right hip in a black leather holster on his belt. Officer Lucas gave that firearm to Officer Keith Kummer who then unloaded the firearm. There was a 9mm round in the chamber of the weapon.

Grosskreutz was transported to St. Luke's Hospital where a blood draw was performed. Officer Lucas witnessed the draw from Grosskreutz's right arm. The two tubes of blood were then sealed and turned over to Officer Lucas. Officer Lucas then brought the blood back to the Greenfield Police Department property room. Detective Brian Wallander would then take Grosskreutz's blood to the Wisconsin State Crime Laboratory to be analyzed. Toxicologist Leah Macans analyzed the blood taken from Grosskreutz and reports an ethanol level of 0.159 grams per 100 milliliters.

The other male refused to provide identification and again stated that officers needed a warrant to be on his property. I recognized this individual as Gaige Grosskruetz from previous professional contacts and was able to provide his information to dispatch.

While providing information to dispatch Gaige began to approach Officer Bybee in an aggressive manner, causing Officer Bybee to draw his Taser and order Gaige to step back. After officer Bybee repeated the order for Gaige to step back he eventually did and Officer Bybee holstered his Taser.

Dispatch advised that Blake and Gaige did not have any warrants. Blake was given his driver's license back, instructed to turn down the music, and informed he was free to go.

During our contact with Gaige he pulled out his cell phone and began recording our interaction with him and telling us to get off his property. I again informed Gaige that we were lawfully there due to a noise complaint that had been called in by a citizen. I attempted to explain to Gaige that he needed to turn his music down and go inside for the night. While I was trying to explain this to Gaige he continued to talk over me and state that we needed to get off his property. I informed Gaige that I was attempting to give him a warning for the noise ordinance violation and he stated "I don't care just give me a ticket."

At this time Officer Goodlet had arrived on scene and had attempted to speak with Gaige without success. Gaige was informed that he would be receiving citations in the mail for violating Ashland city ordinances and officers cleared from the call.

Gaige also arrived at a later traffic stop conducted by Officer Bybee at approximately 0230 Hrs. (See DR#A2-19-01206.)

On 11-04-19 at 12:12 AM Officer Kroll and I, Officer Bybee, were dispatched to 801 7th Ave East in the City of Ashland for a noise complaint involving loud music.

Contact with Gaige Grosskruetz and Blake Windham:

I patrolled the area with my squad windows rolled down and I could hear loud music being played one block away from 801 7th Ave East. I arrived on scene and could hear loud music coming from the house at 801 7th Ave East. I parked my squad on the east side of the house. There were no outside lights turned on and the yard was dark. I exited my squad and was approached by a male subject who charged towards me. The male yelled, "Do you have a warrant, get the fuck out of here." BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On 08/15/20 at 2359hrs. officers made contact with a male who initially refused to identify himself and was detained for prowling. The male, identified by AFIS as Gaige P. Grosskreutz M/W 11/04/93, was observed on west drive of the police parking lot video taping personal vehicles inside the lot. This lot is labeled as "Employee/Staff Entrance Only."

After being detained, Gaige was released with no action taken. Gaige's vehicle was located in the 2300blk S. 117 St.

OBSERVATIONS

On 08/16/20 at 0103hrs. I observed Gaige walking in the grass on the south side of the police parking area between the fence and the driveway near the fence opening for vehicles. Gaige appeared to be recording the vehicles inside the fence.

When I asked Gaige what he was doing his explanation was nothing and that he could be here.

This area of the police department property does not have sidewalks, commonly has marked squads parked along it (which it had at the time), is not well lit, and is not an area commonly visited by the public. I also knew from the prior contact that Gaige was parked in the 2300blk S. 117 St. raising concerns that he was attempting to conceal his identity as well as his motive for lurking around the police department and rear parking lot.

ARREST OF GAIGE

Based on Gaige's previous attempt to withhold his identity, his parking away from the property which he decided to lurk around, his previous prowling warning for being in this same area, the time of night, Gaige concealing himself by walking in the grass rather than a sidewalk or driveway, and Gaige having no explanation or reason for being in the area, I arrested Gaige for prowling.

Gaige was handcuffed and conveyed to booking.

In booking Gaige refused to provide a current address stating he was still living in Ashland despite having recent contacts with WAPD.
